

For Proper Evacuation Action

Make sure to evacuate at the alert levels

What evacuation action should you take?



Find your home on the hazard map

Your area is NOT colored

Evacuate as necessary using the evacuation information from your municipality as a guide.

※ Even if there is danger of flooding, it is possible to remain in your home and stay safe if

- ① Your home is outside the zone at high risk of homes being destroyed in a flood
- ② Your are in a place higher up than the flood depth
- ③ You can wait until the water recedes if there is a flood, and have enough food, water and other supplies.

※ Even if there is the danger of a landslide, it is possible to remain in your home and stay safe if you live high up, such as in a sturdy, multi-story apartment building.

Exception



Your area is colored

There is the danger of a disaster, so in principle, you need to evacuate to somewhere outside your home.



Evacuate to the evacuation shelters of your area

※ The shelters are designated by your municipality. Check during normal times.



Evacuate to the safe home of the relative or acquaintance
